

Chairman Bart Muller called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. Those present were Commissioners Muller, Earl Haringa, Matt Scott, Mark Swartz and Thomas Lindquist; Chief Aaron Mundello; Assistant Chief Craig Lundquist; Captain Jose Ramirez; Firefighters Zach Grimes, Jeremy Davis and Angel Velazquez; and Board Clerk Lisa Wynn.

Scott led the flag salute.

The minutes of the April meeting were approved as presented.

Chief Mundello reported that:

- The roster stands at 32 with 3 firefighters on a leave of absence
- AMR is waiting on the new dispatch system to be finalized to issue reimbursement checks
- 6 Denair firefighters are attending the So. County Fire Academy which began April 6
- Stanislaus County OES is continuing to implement First Due, an emergency management system
- 2026 CalFire 50/50 grant has been submitted focusing on PPE
- Denair Community Services District will not require a backflow valve on the irrigation water meter
- OES 350 is out of service due to a water pressure issue

Scott/Swartz moved to pay the bills (schedule attached). Motion carried.

There were 40 fire calls in April with the breakdown as follows: 21 EMS; 3 fire alarms; 1 gas leak; 2 grass fires; 1 injury traffic collision; 3 mutual aids; 1 other fire; 5 public assists; 1 smoke check; 1 vehicle fire and 1 wire down.

The San Joaquin Valley Air Pollution Control Board grant will pay approximately \$18,000 to replace Quint38.

Swartz moved that up to \$5,000 be allocated to send a board member and a firefighter to Pennsylvania to inspect a 2004 ladder truck currently for sale. Scott seconded the motion and the motion carried.

Swartz moved that the Memorandum of Understanding between Denair High School and Denair Fire Protection District proposing a partnership between districts to provide emergency services training to high school students be accepted as presented. Lindquist seconded the motion and the motion carried.

The annual Tri-Tip Barbecue is scheduled for September.

Denair Firefighters Association will host a lunch at the station for the Champ Camp students on Saturday, June 13.

The County Wildland Training will be held June 5-7, 2026 at Turlock Lake.

Denair Fire Department Muster Team will participate in the West Stanislaus County Fire Muster at the Patterson Apricot Fiesta on Saturday, May 30.

Captain Ramirez is continuing training with the Rapid Extraction Module Support team.

The meeting was adjourned at 7:36 p.m.
